Dear ISPRS member,

This letter comes to you from the new ISPRS Council elected last year in Melbourne, Australia. After a few months of getting organized, the society is now fully operational again, and I thought this to be a very good opportunity to let you know the latest developments.

In December, we had a very productive first meeting of Council and Technical Commission Presidents at the Southwest Jiaotong University in Chengdu, China, perfectly organised by a very hospitable local host. In the meeting we have taken all necessary steps towards setting up the eight Technical Commissions under the leadership of the new Presidents:

Commission II: Songlian Li (Canada)

Commission III: Konrad Schindler (Switzerland)

Commission IV: Jiang Jie (China)

Commission V: Fabio Remondino (Italy)
Commission VI: Jianya Gong (China)
Commission VII: Filiz Sunar (Turkey)
Commission VIII: Vinay K. Dadhwal (India)

Details about the new working groups and their plans for the next four years will be available on isprs.org very soon.

Among other things, the Melbourne Congress saw the first volume of the ISPRS Annals. While ISPRS will continue to publish the well-known Archives, which are based on a normal review process, the new Annals are full paper, double-blind, peer reviewed proceedings. ISPRS will continue to improve its publications. For example, we are currently working with the new publisher Copernicus to have the proceedings indexed in the Web of Science.

Another point worth mentioning is that our *ISPRS Journal of Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing* now ranks third on a world-wide scale of scientific remote sensing journals - a clear success of our outgoing editor-in-chief, George Vosselman. George has done a tremendous
